Post-doc at Catholic University, visiting at FEEM

Jacopo Bonan is a Research Fellow at the Department of Mathematics and Physics of the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart (Brescia) and Visiting Fellow at Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei (FEEM), Milan.

He was working in the project "Laboratorio Expo" sponsored by Feltrinelli Foundation.

After his graduate studies in economics at the University of Milan-Bicocca, he obtained the MSc in Economics at the University of Edinburgh (UK). He completed a PhD in Economics at the University of Milan-Bicocca in April 2013.

His research focuses on Development Economics with an emphasis on health, agriculture, energy poverty, formal and informal financial institutions in Sub Saharan Africa. He is part of a research team investigating the impact of health programs in Senegal in 2010 and 2012. He is currently investigating the impact of an agricultural extensive services project in Ethiopia and the barriers to energy access in Mali. For all research projects he has been the main coordinator of household surveys on the field, designed and supervised the evaluation design, processed and analysed data. He also worked as a research assistant at the Social Security Department of the International Labour Organization (ILO) and taught Development Economics (master students) at the University of Milan-Bicocca.
